Supervises a specialty caseload of predominantly female offenders in the office and field. Prepare reports and recommendations for sentencing and violations. Testify in Court. Screen for substance abuse. Maintain detailed records of case activity. Collaborate efforts with outside agencies to unify efforts.

Correctional Officer, Utah Department of Corrections (4/2013-1/2014)

Salt Lake City, Utah (Halfway House)

Maintain public safety by supervising the accountability of offenders during their stabilization into society, and employment while at the halfway house. Perform pat downs, property searches, and room searches to monitor compliance with parole agreements. Assisted agents in conducting field visits to monitor compliance of individuals who are on probation and parole.

Infirmiry Utah State Prison: Maintain safety between medical staff and inmates receiving medical treatment. Determine appropriate sanctions for inmates that violate state law and prison policy. Supervision of mentally ill inmates to prevent self-inflicted injuries and suicide.
